RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE PARENT / GUARDIAN

- To pay all school fees and all official fees to the school bursar in time. All requirements must be got on the first day.
- To keep my child smart and clean in his / her uniforms throughout the term. Well labeled uniforms are strictly bought from school.

Order of uniforms

(Monday; normal class uniform with black shoes), (Tuesday; decade wear with black shoes), (Wednesday; sportswear and white canvas shoes), (Thursday; normal class uniform with black shoes), (Friday; sportswear and white canvas shoes).

- To co-operate with the school to cater for the child's health.
- To continue following up on the child's performance, by checking his/her progress by signing his / her homework daily, showing up on visitation days a class tour with the teacher and be able to get academic accountability. Plus collecting reports in person.
- To make sure the child gets to and from school on time every day and to keep an open communication with the school in case of difficulties.
- To be the immediate promoter of the school to friends, family, and the community at large.
- To understand that the school is not liable for anything that happens to your child at home or on his / her way to and from home if you agree that the child doesn't use school transport. Parents must sign a consent form to agree that the child will bring him / herself to school without guidance.
- Not to carry any cooked food of any kind to school. Only ready to drink juice, snacks and milk are allowed and they are kept by the school.
- Shouldn't go to the dormitory when it's not visitation day or when not permitted by the authorities from the office.
- Parents should only visit during week days and working hours and this visit should be reported to and allowed by the office.
- To bring up a well behaved child and enforce good morals at school and at home.
- To dress decently while going to school. Parents are not allowed to dress in miniskirts, very tight clothes, transparent clothes and in any way that contradicts with the moral ethics of the school.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CHILD

1. OBEDIENCE:

All children must obey the school rules and regulations plus the staff, prefects and monitors. Any pupil reported breaking the school rules and regulations will be cautioned.

2. PUNCTUALITY:

For the efficiency of work, pupils are to attend school on the first day of the term to facilitate the beginning of lessons and to arrive at school in time i.e.: before 7:00 am and must not leave school before 5:00pm, any pupil who wishes to leave the school must seek prior written permission from the teacher on duty.

3. ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:

All pupils of this school are required to work tirelessly so that they meet the required academic qualifications. People below the average standards of the school will always repeat classes for improvement, therefore pupils are advised to do their best, hand in their assignments, do their homework and have their parents sign it daily.

4. DAMAGE OF PROPERTY:

Any pupil who steals, damages, loses or misplaces school property or fellow pupils will have to pay or refund it or unless that pupil will be dismissed from school.

5. WORSHIP:

Quality school is a private school which honors all religious denominations, Muslims and Christians must all attend their respective worship to uplift their moral and spiritual behavior.

6. LANGUAGE OF COMMUNICATION:

We admit pupils from different tribes and cultures and therefore the medium of communication is English. Therefore it must be spoken at all times for pupils to master their answering techniques.

7. DISCIPLINE:

Discipline in this school is taken as paramount. Any pupil with indiscriminate behavior, pornographic behavior, immorality, insolence, insubordination, or other acts of indiscipline will not be accepted and lead to suspension and automatic dismissal.

8. SMARTNESS:

All pupils are supposed to be dressed in proper; clean well labeled, ironed uniforms for easy identification and they must keep it tidy at all times with black shoes or white canvas shoes. Any pupil dressed in a casual wear will not be allowed in the school. All hair should be short and well-trimmed, girls can plait kaswayiri puff.

9. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

The school is a vocationalised school which puts an importance on various skills. It is a must that all pupils participate in those activities. They include sports, MDD, art and crafts.
